Package 101 Statistical Transparency of Policing

<u>Package Description</u> Package 101 provides funding for the Statistical Transparency of Policing (STOP) Program in the Criminal Justice Commission's budget. Created by HB 2355 in 2017, the STOP Program requires law enforcement agencies in Oregon to report on all discretionary traffic and pedestrian stops.

This package adds \$841,046 General Fund for maintenance and hosting costs of the STOP Program's data collection tool. It funds \$39,180 General Fund for the reclassification of one position, and adds \$159,159 of General Fund and \$636,633 of Other Funds expenditure limitation, one-time-only for 2019-21, to pay for four limited-duration positions (4.00 FTE) and associated services and supplies. These positions support the implementation of the STOP program in Tier 2 and Tier 3 law enforcement agencies (those with fewer than 99 patrol officers), modifications and improvements to the data collection tool, and data analysis and research design for the required reporting on traffic stops.

The Other Funds expenditure limitation is supported by a Racial Profiling Data Collection formula grant from the National Highway Transportation Safety Administration.
