

**SB 92 STAFF MEASURE SUMMARY**

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**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Authorizes city to provide for as much as a 20-year ramp-up to full taxation rate for property in an annexed territory. Adds, for purposes of "island annexation," corporate boundaries of another city as a permitted portion of the boundary surrounding the territory to be annexed.

*FISCAL: Has minimal fiscal impact*

*REVENUE: No revenue impact*

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

Annexation is the process of incorporating a piece of property into the boundaries of a city, making the property and those who live there eligible for services provided by the city. This action can be initiated by the city or by the property owner. Annexation is a locally driven process with guiding state statutes.

Senate Bill 92 would authorize a city to provide for as much as a 20-year ramp-up to full taxation rate for property in an annexed territory.
