**Subject:** SB 19 – Relating to human services

SB 19 primarily relates to the Intellectual and Developmental Disabilities program at the Department of Human Services (DHS). The bill modifies adult foster home classification statues to so that program specific requirements for home types can more easily be identified, adds publicly funded developmental disability service providers to the list of mandatory reporters, makes certain program definitions consistent with federal language, definitions, authorizes the program to adopt rules for imposing civil penalties, and aligns statute with practice for the DHS volunteer program.

The bill, preliminary staff measure summary, fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure previously had hearings in the Senate Committee on Human Services on 1/22/19, 2/28/19, and 3/26/19. The bill has a minimal fiscal impact. No changes to the bill are being recommended by LFO.

## **Final Subcommittee Action**

LFO recommends that SB 91 be moved to the Ways and Means Full Committee.
