## SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

## SB 5533 Department of Public Safety Standards and Training

SB 5533 is the budget bill for the Department of Public Safety Standards and Training.

DPSST trains and maintains certifications for more than 41,000 public safety professionals and volunteers in Oregon at its main campus in Salem and at satellite locations throughout the state.

The Public Safety Subcommittee approved a total budget for DPSST of \$65.4 million and 152 positions (149.87 FTE). DPSST's criminal justice training programs are funded primarily through the Criminal Fines Account, and the Subcommittee recommends reducing four training classes from the 2019-21 training calendar in order to meet statewide budget reduction targets. Funding was provided for two training positions to continue implementing the STOP program, which addresses racial profiling during traffic and pedestrian stops; and for deferred maintenance projects at the agency's Salem Public Safety Center Campus. The Subcommittee discussed the agency's performance measures and approved raising the targets for several customer service measures.

The Public Safety Subcommittee recommends SB 5533 be amended by the -1 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
