Subject: HB 3309 – Relating to the State Department of Geology and Mineral Industries

The legislation repeals the restriction that new essential facilities may not be built in the tsunami inundation zone, and repeals the requirement that the Department of Geology and Mineral Industries (DOGAMI) adopt tsunami inundation zone parameters, as well as changes exemptions under the definition of surface mining.

The bill has a minimal fiscal impact
