Subject: SB 492 – Relating to support provided to parents with disabilities

SB 492 clarifies state policy around child reunification, stating that child and family reunification services will be provided in such a way that parents and guardians with disabilities will receive services and opportunities equal to those provided to individuals without disabilities.

The bill, preliminary staff measure summary, and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure previously had hearings in the Senate Committee on Human Services on February 12 and 26, 2019. The bill has a minimal fiscal impact. No changes to the bill are being recommended by LFO.
