**Subject:** SB 815 – Relating to information that must be provided by residential

care facilities

SB 815 requires residential care facilities to provide specified information to individuals at the time the individual applies for admission to the facility and upon request.

The recommended amendment, preliminary staff measure summary, and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The measure previously had hearings in Senate Human Services on March 18, April 3, and April 8, 2019.

The -A3 amendment delays the publication of the first quality metrics report required under ORS 443.446 from July 1, 2020 to July 1, 2021. The amendment has a minimal fiscal impact.
