Oregon County Programs

Overview

- History
- Data-tracking
- Other items

In the last 24 months

- 308 youth received BRS treatment in County programs
- 6 received Independent Living support in a County program
- A total of 314 youth were served in County programs

Data Tracking

- Age range is 13-17 years
- Average length of stay is 49 days
- Monthly child safety visits occur

Data Tracking

- No County programs utilize seclusion practices
- Four County programs do not utilize physical restraint
- Douglas County utilizes the evidence-based model of the Crisis Prevention Institute
