**Subject:** SB 488 - relating to immunization against influenza for incarcerated persons

SB 488 requires the Department of Corrections to offer, annually, each adult in custody an appointment to receive a flu vaccination at no cost to the adult in custody. The adult in custody may decline the offer.

The Department estimates that SB 488 will increase the number of adults in custody receiving the influenza vaccine each year. The cost of purchasing additional vaccines is estimated to be \$114,182 in the 2019-21 biennium. The -A3 amendment adds a General Fund appropriation of \$114,182 to the Department’s budget for that purpose.

**Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A3 amendment.
