**Subject:** HB 2515 – Relating to correctional facilities

HB 2515 requires correctional facilities to provide a range of sanitary products to adults in custody at no cost, and to keep a sufficient supply of such products on hand.

The Department of Corrections currently provides regular absorbency sanitary products, but not super absorbency products, postpartum pads, or panty liners. The cost of providing these items to adults in custody is estimated to be \$102,108 in the 2019-21 biennium. The -A6 amendment adds a General Fund appropriation of \$102,108 to the Department’s budget for the upcoming biennium.

**Recommended Changes**

LFO recommends adoption of the -A6 amendment.
