Subject: SB 372 – Relating to notification of parties with interest in towed vehicles.

SB 372 A requires tower to provide notice to owner and lienholder of vehicle within three calendar days of towing vehicle, or one calendar day if lienholder's e-mail address is available in electronic system established by Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT). Reduces amount tower can claim in lien if notice requirement not satisfied. Declares emergency, effective on passage.

Recommended Changes

The -A5 amendment deletes the requirement for ODOT to provide an electronic portal and changes the notification requirement from calendar days to business days.

LFO recommends adoption of the -A5 amendment.

MOTION: I move adoption of the -A5 amendment to SB 372 A. (VOTE)
