**Subject:** SB 41 - A – Oil spill prevention fees

SB 41 established two new fees and increases existing oil spill prevention fees charged by the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). Fee revenue is used to fund DEQ’s Oil Spill Prevention and Contingency Planning Program.

DEQ anticipates that changes to fees will increase Other Funds revenue by \$1.1 million in the 2019-21 biennium and \$1.2 million in the 2021-23 biennium. Increased fee revenue will be used to add one position, an Information Systems Specialist 5 (1.00 FTE), at an estimated cost of \$224,097 Other Funds each biennium. This position is included in the agency’s budget bill, HB 5017.

The bill, preliminary staff measure summary, and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). These documents contain detailed lists of the proposed fee amounts.
