Subject: SB 884 - A – Water Pollution Control Revolving Fund

SB 884 expands qualified to uses of the Clean Water State Revolving Fund, which is administered by the Department of Environmental Quality (DEQ). The fund provides below-market rate loans for water pollution control activities.

This bill will allow certified community development financial institutions to receive monies from the fund, in order to finance projects to repair or replace failing on-site septic systems with connections to an available sewer.

DEQ anticipates that funding resources and current staffing levels are sufficient to cover the needs of newly eligible recipients, and no additional expenditure limitation is required at this time.

The bill, preliminary staff measure summary, and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS).
