Subject:	HB 2333 – Relating to recreational vehicles

This bill clarifies the difference between recreational vehicles which are titled and registered with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) and park model recreational vehicles (also known as "tiny homes on wheels"), which are more than eight and half feet wide and may be titled, but not registered, with ODOT. The bill also removes recreational vehicles from Department of Consumer and Business Services (DCBS) regulation.

The -A3 amendment includes recreational vehicles that are more than eight and half feet wide in the definition of manufactured structures for property tax purposes and makes other technical changes.

DCBS anticipates a revenue reduction of \$571,032 for 2019-21 in its Recreational Vehicle and Manufactured Housing Inspection Programs. The department will review the program during the biennium and return to the Legislature next session with any proposed fee or position adjustments.

ODOT will incur some costs for the registration changes, but those are anticipated to be minimal.

Recommended Changes
