SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 5510 Department of Fish and Wildlife

SB 5510 is the budget bill for the Department of Fish and Wildlife. The recommended budget for the agency is \$391,911,959 total funds, which is a 7.5% increase from the legislatively approved budget for the 2017-19 biennium. General Fund in the budget is increased by 18.6% and Measure 76 Lottery Funds by 43.4%.

The budget includes additional General Fund for pinniped predation, wolf plan implementation, water quality work, steelhead production at Santiam Hatchery, and an anti-poaching campaign that includes funding five Department of State Police positions and a Department of Justice attorney to assist with local prosecutions.

The Measure 76 Lottery Funds is increased by \$2 million from the current service level to utilize a one-time available fund balance from the increased May 2019 forecast. Federal Funds are 7.1% higher than the 2017-19 legislatively approved levels due to increased Pittman-Robertson apportionment. The total number of positions is increased by 22.

The Natural Resources Subcommittee recommends SB 5510 be amended by the -2 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
