SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 22 Relating to behavioral health homes

The Patient-Centered Primary Care Home Program within the Oregon Health Authority administers the application, recognition, and verification process for primary care clinics and practices to apply to become Patient-Centered Primary Care Homes.

SB 22 amends statutes relating to this program to specify the inclusion of behavioral health homes in order to continue the integration of physical health and behavioral health services.

OHA estimates the fiscal impact of this bill to be \$325,054 General Fund plus \$235,446 Federal Funds and 2 positions (1.76 FTE) for the 2019-21 biennium. Funding to support this work will be included in the agency's 2019-21 budget bill.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 22 be reported out do pass.
