

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 994
Relating to juveniles

SB 994 requires that prior to a person releasing a child in protective custody to the noncustodial parent a criminal records check be conducted by the Department of Human Services on the noncustodial parent and all adults in the home.

The bill has an indeterminate fiscal impact. If, after the bill is operational, DHS identifies a quantifiable and unmanageable workload and/or cost change directly related to this bill, the agency may seek a budget adjustment.

The Human Services Subcommittee recommends SB 994 be reported out do pass.
