WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Modifies a requirement for a high school to qualify as a small high school for the purpose of State School Fund distributions. First applies to the 2019-20 distributions. Takes effect on July 1, 2019.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

-2 Replaces the weighted average daily membership (ADMw) cap of 10,500 in the introduced version with 9,500.

BACKGROUND:

Under current law, one of the requirements to qualify as a small high school is that a school be in a school district that has a weighted average daily membership (ADMw) of less than 8,500. This bill with -2 amendment increases the ADMw upper bound to 9,500. All other requirements, including the average daily membership (ADM) cap, remain the same.
