**Subject:** SB 445 – Relating to the Invasive Species Council

SB 445 relates to the Oregon Invasive Species Council, which is housed in the Oregon Department of Agriculture. This measure requires the Invasive Species Council to report on their activities each biennium to an interim committee of the Legislative Assembly related to natural resources. The measure also changes the composition of the council and increases the number of council members, from 18 to 22.

The Invasive Species Council is funded by a mix of Lottery, Other, and Federal Funds. Their budget is part of the Department of Agriculture budget bill, HB 5002. For the 2019-21 biennium, the Department of Agriculture budget bill includes additional Lottery Funds to support the work of the Council.

The bill, preliminary staff measure summary, and fiscal impact statement are available on the Oregon Legislative Information System (OLIS). The bill has a minimal fiscal impact.
