Our organization and its individual members oppose SB 1050 and request a "NO" vote since this bill would be a major negative change to our land use system.

There are many reasons we oppose this bill. Here are a few:

- 1. SB 1050 breaks the compact from M49 in 2007.
- 2. When we heard that any measure including the phrase "not withstanding M49" developers were outraged. SB 1050 will create mistrust that M49 will be protected in future legislation.
- 3. SB 1050 will have a significant impact to our land use system.
- 4. SB 1050 puts at risk rural land from other conditional uses normally associated with residential development.

SB 1050 is ill conceived and presents a real threat to Oregon's landscape. We therefore request a "NO" vote on this measure.
