

SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

HB 2910

Relating to the Oregon Promise Program

HB 2910 extends the eligibility for the Oregon Promise Program to individuals under the supervision of the Department of Corrections and the Oregon Youth Authority. The eligibility for the program extends for six months after the individual's period of incarceration ends and they have completed prior educational requirements for the Oregon Promise Program.

The bill will cover approximately 146 individuals and the bill appropriates \$200,000 General Fund to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission to cover the additional grants. The grants are separate and distinct from the Oregon Promise program and will be administered separately.

The Education Subcommittee recommends HB 2910 be amended by the -A9 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
