Summary of Revenue Changes

House Bill 3397 appropriates \$111,128 General Fund to the Oregon Health Authority (OHA) to support costs for the Oregon Medicaid Purchasing Cooperative as an advisory committee to the OHA and the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee.

Summary of Education Subcommittee Action

House Bill 3397 establishes the Oregon Medicaid Purchasing Cooperative as an advisory committee to OHA and the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee. The cooperative is charged with identifying opportunities to lower costs in purchasing prescription drugs. OHA is directed to provide staff support to the cooperative. Additionally, the measure allows OHA to enter into an agreement with a third party to assist by acting as a purchasing agent to ensure the authority pays the lowest cost for any prescription drug purchased for recipients of medical assistance in Oregon. The measure requires OHA to report to the Legislature on the activities of the Pharmacy and Therapeutics Committee and the Oregon Medicaid Purchasing Cooperative.

The bill appropriates \$111,128 General Fund to OHA, which will support the costs associated with establishing the Oregon Medicaid Purchasing Cooperative as an advisory committee to the OHA.
