SUBCOMMITTEE RECOMMENDATION

SB 1005 Relating to public safety

SB 1005 adds two members to the Task Force on School Safety, directs the task force to submit a report to the Legislature, and extends the sunset of the task force to December 31st, 2021. The bill also establishes regulations for kratom products. It directs the Department of Agriculture to promulgate rules about testing, labeling, and regulation of kratom; sets an age limit for purchasing kratom products; creates civil and criminal penalties for certain violations; and provides definitions.

The Capital Construction subcommittee discussed developing a proposal for kratom regulation for consideration in an upcoming legislative session. The Subcommittee approved amendments that remove kratom provisions from the bill, and amendments that resolve conflicts between SB 1008 and SB 1013.

The Capital Construction Subcommittee recommends SB 1005 be amended by the -A15 amendment and be reported out do pass, as amended.
