SUMMARY

Establishes limitations and deadlines for legislative measures for 2020 regular session of Eightieth Legislative Assembly.

CONCURRENT RESOLUTION

Be It Resolved by the Legislative Assembly of the State of Oregon:

(1) This resolution constitutes a rule of proceeding of the Senate and the House of Representatives of the Eightieth Legislative Assembly.

(2) The Senate and the House of Representatives agree to the following limitations for the 2020 regular session:

(a) Each Senator may request the Office of the Legislative Counsel to prepare, and may submit for introduction, no more than one draft of a measure.

(b) Each Representative may request the Office of the Legislative Counsel to prepare, and may submit for introduction, no more than two drafts of measures.

(c) Each interim committee of the Senate and each interim committee of the House of Representatives may request the Office of the Legislative Counsel to prepare, and may submit for introduction, no more than three drafts of measures.

(d) The Governor may request the Office of the Legislative Counsel to prepare, and may submit for introduction, no more than five drafts of measures on behalf of the executive branch of state government.

(e) The Chief Justice of the Supreme Court may request the Office of the Legislative Counsel to prepare, and may submit for introduction, no more

1 than five drafts of measures on behalf of the judicial branch of state gov-
2 ernment.

3 (3) The limitations on introduction of measures in subsection (2) of this
4 resolution do not apply to:

5 (a) The Joint Committee on Ways and Means, with respect to appropri-
6 ation or fiscal measures;

7 (b) Measures requested and approved for introduction by the President
8 of the Senate; or

9 (c) Measures requested and approved for introduction by the House
10 Committee on Rules.

11 (4) All requests to prepare drafts of measures must be accompanied by a
12 brief summary of the problem sought to be addressed, the proposed solution
13 to the problem and any other relevant information about the proposed
14 measure.

15 (5) The Senate and the House of Representatives shall adhere to the fol-
16 lowing schedule and deadlines for the 2020 regular session of the Eightieth
17 Legislative Assembly:

18 (a) Members, committees, the Governor and the Chief Justice shall submit
19 requests for drafts of measures to the Office of the Legislative Counsel on
20 or before 5 p.m. on November 22, 2019.

21 (b) The Office of the Legislative Counsel shall deliver drafts of measures
22 to requesters on or before 5 p.m. on January 13, 2020.

23 (c) Requesters shall submit drafts of measures for introduction to the
24 Senate Desk or the House Desk no later than 5 p.m. on January 17, 2020.

25 (6) The President of the Senate, the House Committee on Rules and the
26 Joint Committee on Ways and Means are not subject to the deadlines de-
27 scribed in subsection (5) of this resolution.

28 (7) The rules of the Senate and the House of Representatives apply to
29 matters not specified in this resolution.
