Work Session Recommendations

HB 2018 with the -A4 amendment provides the language necessary to transfer the Statewide Longitudinal Data System (SLDS) from the Chief Education Office to the Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC). The Chief Education Office is scheduled to sunset on June 30, 2019. The language provides necessary transfer language regarding obligations, liabilities, agreements and other responsibilities. The amended bill also insures that HECC may share data with various people and entities which is a primary purpose of the SLDS. All data to be shared is subject to strict confidentiality requirements and individuals will not be able to be identified.

The 2019-21 budget for the SLDS is included in HB 5047, the Student Success Act as a blend of General Fund and Other Funds. SB 5507 includes the positions authority for the SLDS staff.

### **Recommended Changes**
