**Subject:** HB 2436 - Relating to removal-fill laws

Work Session Recommendations

HB 2436 directs the Oregon Department of State Lands (DSL) to develop a proposal, in collaboration with certain state and federal agencies, for the partial assumption of the authority to administer permits for the discharge of dredge or fill materials under section 404 of the Federal Water Pollution Control Act. That authority is limited to specific development activities defined by the bill.

The proposal also must include recommendations for legislation to be introduced during the 2020 legislative session to provide adequate legal authority for the state to implement the partial assumption program. Those recommendations must also ensure that if specified laws become operative, the resulting removal-fill permitting or regulatory requirements for activities not included in partial assumption do not exceed current requirements.

The bill eliminates certain restrictions on the purchase of credits from the Oregon Removal-Fill Mitigation Fund and includes a blank appropriation from the General Fund to DSL for the purposes of the bill.

## **Recommended Changes**

The A10 amendments eliminate the blank General Fund appropriation and provide a \$355,776 Other Funds expenditure limitation increase for the Department of State Lands for the costs associated with the proposal for partial assumption of the federal program.

The amendments amend statute to remove the requirement that the DSL director consider all items of an enumerated list of standards related to a removal-fill permit application. And allows the director to determine that an application is, or is not, consistent with statutory requirements for a permit to be issued, regardless of consideration of those items.

LFO recommends adoption of the -A10 amendment.
