I am a cyclist and just wanted to write in and express my support of Senate Bill 998. We should be doing all we can to make cycling a viable form of transportation. For those just starting out it can be especially difficult to frequently come to a complete stop as they may not be confident in unclipping/clipping in. Add that to the fact that if you haven't ridden very much you may be out of shape, so starting up again from a dead stop makes your ride feel much harder than it needs to.

It may seem like a small change in the law, but it will make a big difference in lowering the hurdles that beginning cyclists face. By making cycling a bit easier, we can help drive adoption and make a healthier, less fossil fuel dependent society.
