I don't have statistics nor a fancy power point. I'm just a nobody who rides a bike and drives a car. I already see confusion amongst the biking community on the responsibilities created by this bill (especially at four-way stops) and in general I lean against changing well-known traffic controls from "do this" to "do this except when" with no indication on the signal itself. This Bill puts the onus on a cyclist to make good decisions and not put themselves in harm's way instead of simply obeying an established traffic control that has been demonstrated to separate traffic.
