I am a resident of Portland and strongly support the passage and implementation of SB 998 that allows cyclists to enter an intersection controlled by specified traffic control devices without stopping.

As a bicycle commuter myself, this kind of practice would greatly aid in my efficiency and general awareness.

Please see this study, Compounded Public Cobenefits of the Idaho Law Relaxing Stop Requirements for Cycling, which shows a decline in bicycle injuries after adoption of the Idaho.
