- c. TOTAL JR Grants \$ 50,028,467

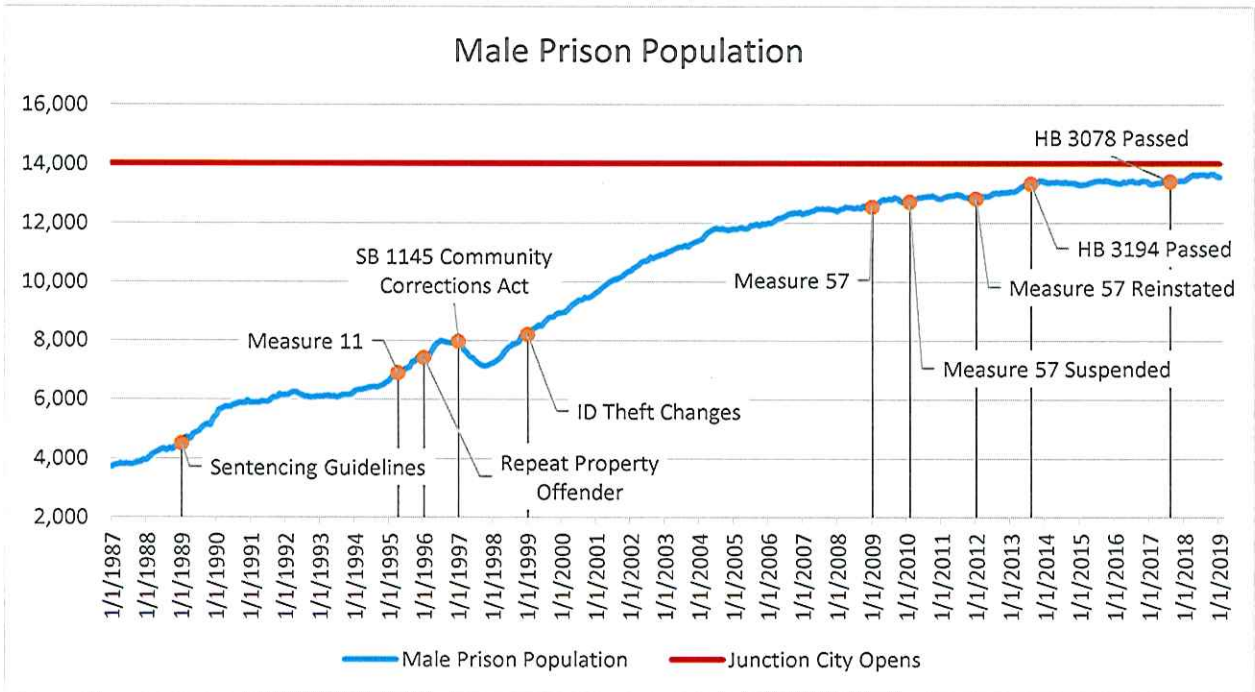
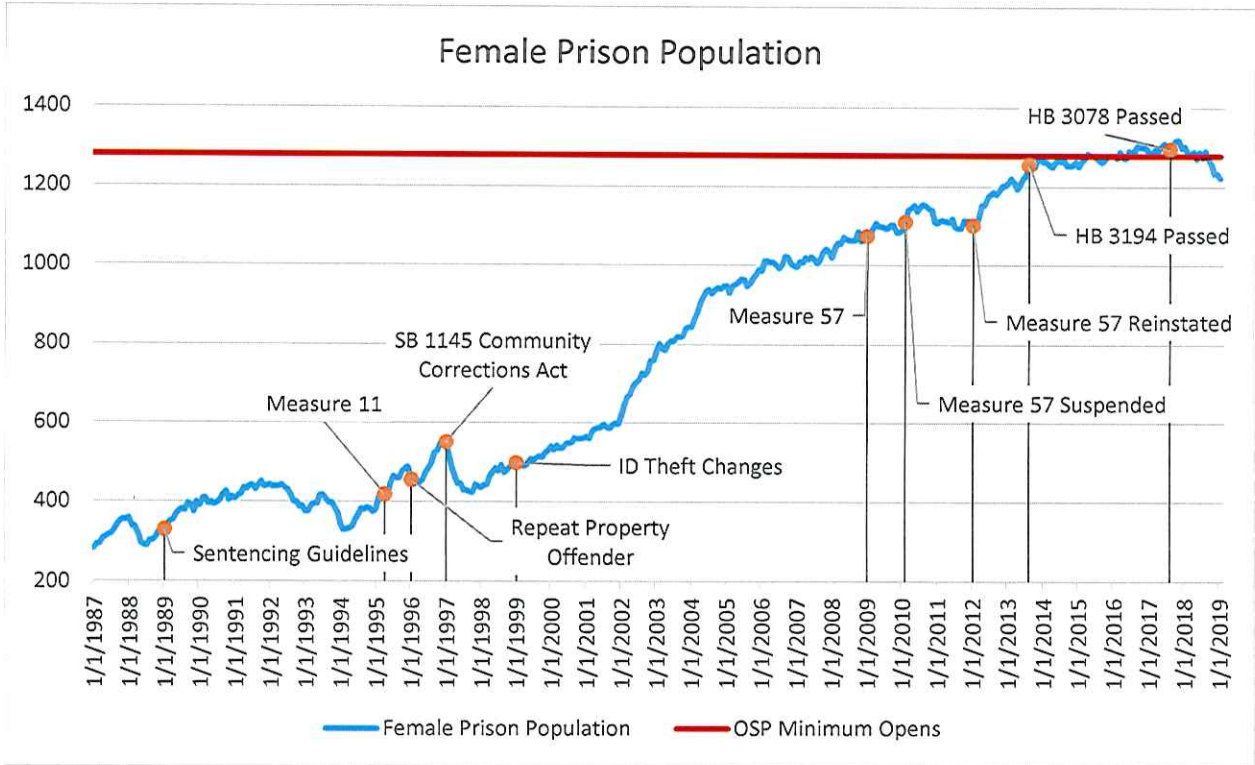
INQUIRY 2

What were the percentages and amounts spent on each category of the pie-chart detailing the Justice Reinvestment Supplemental Grant Spending Breakdown across the 12 participating Oregon counties?

Category	Percentage	Funds
Deputy District Attorneys	38%	\$ 2,687,773
Law Enforcement	17%	\$ 1,218,014
Public Defense Services	4%	\$ 290,700
Victim Services	10%	\$ 700,000
Supervision	22%	\$ 1,508,476
Circuit Courts	6%	\$ 412,714
Data Analysis and Other Support	3%	\$182,323

How much was the Federal Justice Reinvestment: Maximizing State Reform Grant for the LPSCC Coordinator support?


- c. Answered: \$3 million

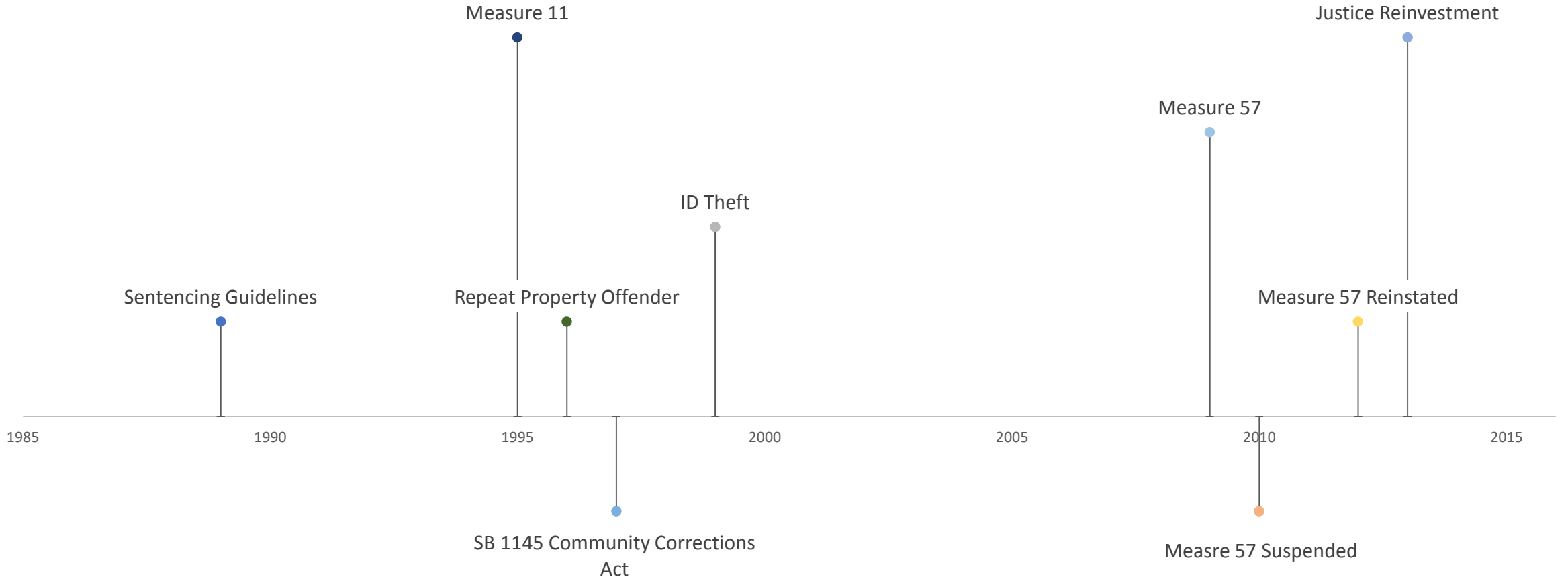
