



HB 3427 makes historic investments in Oregon children and families.

20% of new revenue raised in HB 3427 is dedicated to a package of essential early childhood investments.

- 90% of a child’s brain develops by the age of 5.
- Early childhood is the foundation for all learning and life experiences.
- Kids ready for kindergarten do better all the way through high school.
- Early childhood investments support young children and their families.
- Early childhood investments reduce inequality and create opportunity.

Key Early Learning Investments

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| Early Childhood Equity Fund Culturally specific early learning and parent support programs. | \$10 million |
| Early Intervention/Early Childhood Special Education Services for children with disabilities and developmental delays. | \$37.5 million |
| Oregon Pre-kindergarten and Early Head Start Early learning for more children, expanded hours, better teacher pay. | \$66.8 million |
| Preschool Promise Preschool for more children from low-income families. | \$30.8 million |
| Relief Nurseries Services for families with children at risk of abuse and neglect. | \$2.8 million |
| Healthy Families Oregon Voluntary home visiting services for families with children prenatal to age 3. | \$2 million |
| Parenting Education Supports for parents to nurture healthy child development. | \$1 million |
| Early Childhood Workforce Recruitment, professional learning, and scholarships for early educators. | \$12.5 million |
| State Capacity Program expansion and staffing. | \$2.3 million |
