



VOTE NO ON SB 579

We, the undersigned, urge you to vote no on Senate Bill 579.

SB 579 would remove waiting periods in Oregon's physician-assisted suicide law that are designed to prevent abuse and same-day suicides and to protect vulnerable Oregonians from being coerced into ending their lives.

SB 579 would:

- Make it easier for bad actors to continue to harm people living with disabilities and the elderly, which is already a significant problem in Oregon.
- Remove safeguards promoted by supporters of assisted-suicide.
- Allow someone with malicious intent to pressure a person to request, receive and take the lethal drugs on the same day.

Our laws should protect Oregonians from abuse and coercion, not make it easier to harm them.

We urge you to VOTE NO on SB 579.
