SUMMARY

Exempts from required disclosure pursuant to public records request, home address, home phone number and other specified personal information of county juvenile department employees who primarily perform duties related to youth offenders confined in detention facilities. Requires disclosure of county juvenile department employee information if public interest requires disclosure in particular instance.

Takes effect on 91st day following adjournment sine die.

OPEN GOVERNMENT IMPACT

Legislative Counsel has not adopted standards for drafting measures that establish exemptions from disclosure of public records.

This measure expands the exemption from disclosure of personal information of public safety officers to also include county juvenile department employees who primarily perform duties related to youth offenders confined in detention facilities.

Currently this information is subject to mandatory disclosure under public records law unless another exemption from public disclosure applies.
