**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Revises statutes to maintain accuracy. Corrects punctuation and grammatical errors. Conforms language to legislative form and style. Removes obsolete references, standardizes terminology, and removes statutes from inappropriate series. Corrects citation to federal law. Makes other non-substantive corrections.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- History of reviser's bill
- Error in 1993 Uniform Commercial Code corrected by amendment
- Use of "which" instead of "that"
- Provisions of measure

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

Corrects citations within Uniform Commercial Code.

**BACKGROUND:**

In every long session, the Office of Legislative Counsel introduces a "reviser's bill" to make non-substantive, corrective, and technical changes to Oregon law.

Senate Bill 355-A is this session's reviser's bill.
