Increases membership of Oregon Medical Board by one public member.

Analysis:

The measure would add a third public member to the Oregon Medical Board (OMB) and expand the Board's membership from 13 to 14 members, as non-budgeted positions ineligible for salaries and benefits. OMB estimates \$12,145 increase in Other Funds expenditures in the 2019-21 biennium to provide for the new member's per diem, travel, lodging, and services and supplies. After adjusting for one-time costs, OMB estimates ongoing costs of \$9,828 in 2021-23 biennium.

The cost of the measure is included in the Governor's Recommended Budget, under Policy Option Package 102, and is currently under review by the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
