**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Permits the Oregon Department of Aviation (ODA) to request the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to provide central business services on ODA's behalf. Requires ODOT to provide specified services upon ODA's request.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Value to agency of selecting central services providers
- Support from the Oregon Department of Transportation and the Department of Administrative Services

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

The Oregon Department of Aviation (ODA) promotes, develops, and improves Oregon's aviation system. ODA works in partnership with the Oregon Department of Transportation (ODOT) to administer programs; ODA receives the majority of its Other Funds from the jet fuel tax collected by ODOT. Current statute requires ODOT to provide central services to ODA, including accounting and budget preparation, records and inventory maintenance, financial management, information systems, and human resources. Senate Bill 53 allows ODA to elect which of those services ODOT must provide on ODA's behalf.
