WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Clarifies statutes relating to Veterans' Homes to distinguish between them, provide consistent application of provisions, and make admissions practices uniform.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

• Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA) recent review of statutes concerning Veterans' Homes

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

No amendment.

BACKGROUND:

There are currently two Veterans' Homes in Oregon to provide qualifying veterans with long-term care, one in The Dalles and one in Lebanon, and Oregon law provides for two more. Admittance to a Veterans' Home is a benefit that honorably discharged veterans have earned, that extends to their spouses and to the parents of children who died serving in the U.S. Armed Forces. ODVA conducted a comprehensive review of statutes governing Veterans' Homes, resulting in Senate Bill 37.

Senate Bill 37 clearly identifies each Veterans' Home, making admissions practices uniform and providing consistent application of provisions.
