WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:

Replaces reference to "mental retardation" with "intellectual disabilities" in workers' compensation statute regarding coverage for participants in work experience or school-directed professional training programs.

ISSUES DISCUSSED:

- Underlying policy not changed by measure
- Support of Management-Labor Advisory Committee

EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:

Replaces reference to "mental retardation" with "intellectual disabilities" instead of referencing transition services, as defined by ORS 343.035.

BACKGROUND:

Current law provides that persons with mental retardation who are trainees in a work experience program or a school-directed professional education project are considered to be subject workers of the school district for purposes of workers' compensation insurance laws. House Bill 2406-A replaces "mental retardation" with "intellectual disabilities."
