Measure Description:

Authorizes State Department of Fish and Wildlife to operate wildlife inspection stations for purposes of preventing spread of infections or infestations harmful to wildlife or of furthering wildlife management efforts.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Natural Resources to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure permits the Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW) to operate wildlife inspection stations for the purpose of preventing the spread of infections or infestations harmful to wildlife, and to collect data. The operator of a vehicle transporting any taken wildlife parts, except for wildlife that has been processed by a food establishment, must stop at the station for inspection. The inspection station is required to be staffed by at least one ODFW employee. Failure to stop at an inspection station would constitute a Class A violation.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Department of Fish and Wildlife (ODFW).

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
