Declares the policy of the state is to promote, facilitate, and encourage activities, initiatives, projects and businesses that improve the security of data and electronic communications, and to increase the awareness of cybersecurity risks and the need for proactive cybersecurity risk management for the benefit of Oregon's commercial, educational, governmental, and individual users.

**BACKGROUND:**
