Measure Description:

Provides for cities and counties to certify annually that city or county has not adopted ordinance prohibiting establishment requiring marijuana-related business license and is therefore eligible for distribution of Oregon Marijuana Account moneys.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC), Cities, Counties, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Department of Revenue (DOR)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Economic Development to the House Committee on Revenue.

The measure requires the Department of Administrative Services (DAS) to certify whether a city or county has an ordinance prohibiting the establishment of recreational marijuana businesses in order to determine if the city or county is eligible for distribution of Oregon Marijuana Account moneys.

The measure may have an impact on DAS, the Oregon Liquor Control Commission (OLCC), Cities, Counties, and the Department of Revenue (DOR).
