**Measure Description:**

Removes requirement that intimate image be disclosed through Internet website for crime of unlawful dissemination of an intimate image.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Cities, Department of Corrections (DOC), District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon State Police (OSP), Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Counties, Department of Justice (DOJ), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), Oregon Youth Authority (OYA)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
