Measure Description:

Appropriates moneys to State Forestry Department for 2019-2021 biennium to carry out integrated pest management program to combat Sudden Oak Death.

Analysis:

The legislation appropriates \$1.7 million General Fund, in the 2019-21 biennium, to the State Forestry Department (ODF) for deposit in the State Forestry Department Account to combat the plant disease Sudden Oak Death. ODF must spend \$50,000 of the appropriation on a block grant to assist the Association of Oregon Counties to establish and operate a task force to encourage and coordinate county integrated pest management programs to combat Sudden Oak Death. The remainder of the appropriation, \$1,650,000 is assumed to maintain program funding within ODF and support eradication treatments.
