**WHAT THE MEASURE DOES:**

Revises statutes to maintain accuracy. Corrects punctuation and grammatical errors. Conforms language to legislative form and style. Removes obsolete references, standardizes terminology, and removes statutes from inappropriate series. Corrects citation to federal law. Makes other non-substantive corrections.

**ISSUES DISCUSSED:**

- Focus of changes is technical and non-substantive
- Revisions focus on modernization of language, formatting, references, and changes to cited federal regulations
- Provisions of measure

**EFFECT OF AMENDMENT:**

No amendment.

**BACKGROUND:**

In every long session, the Office of Legislative Counsel introduces a “reviser’s bill” to make non-substantive, corrective, and technical changes to Oregon law.

Senate Bill 355 A is this session's reviser's bill.
