Measure Description:

Directs Department of Human Services to establish pilot program to encourage innovative strategies to strengthen families and build resilient neighborhoods.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Department of Revenue (DOR), Department of Human Services (DHS)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Human Services to the Joint Committee on Tax Expenditures.

The measure requires the Department of Human Services to establish, in collaboration with an advisory committee to be convened by the department, a pilot program in three regions of the state to encourage innovative strategies to strengthen families and build resilient neighborhoods. The bill establishes a tax credit for qualified contributions to selected community agencies.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Department of Revenue and the Department of Human Services.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Tax Expenditures.
