Measure Description:

Authorizes issuance of general obligation bonds under Article XI-Q of Oregon Constitution for construction of a veterans' home in Roseburg, Oregon.

Government Unit(s) Affected:

Bonding, Department of Administrative Services (DAS), Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs (ODVA), Oregon State Treasurer (OST)

Analysis:

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Veterans and Emergency Preparedness to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure authorizes the issuance of general obligation bonds under Article XI-Q of Oregon Constitution in an amount that produces \$17.5 million of net proceeds for construction of a veterans' home in Roseburg, Oregon.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Department of Administrative Services, the Oregon Department of Veterans' Affairs, and the Oregon State Treasurer.

A more complete fiscal analysis on the measure will be prepared as the measure is considered in the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.
