**Measure Description:**

Directs State Board of Education to adopt rules for administration of naloxone or any similar medication designed to rapidly reverse overdose of opioid drug.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

School Districts, Oregon Board of Pharmacy (OBOP), Department of Education (ODE), Oregon State Board of Nursing (OSBN), Education Service Districts (ESD), Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
