**Measure Description:**

Requires Oregon Health Authority to research innovative approaches to delivery and financing of health care in other states and countries and report to interim committees of Legislative Assembly related to health on any practices that could be implemented in this state.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon Health Authority (OHA)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the House Committee on Health Care to the House Committee on Rules.

The measure requires the Oregon Health Authority to research innovative approaches to the delivery and financing of health care in other states and other countries to identify practices that may be employed in Oregon to improve access to and the quality of health care while reducing costs.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on the Oregon Health Authority.
