**Measure Description:**

Increases criminal penalties for offense relating to use of unmanned aircraft system to interfere with aircraft.

Oregon State Police (OSP), District Attorneys and their Deputies (DAs), Oregon Judicial Department (OJD), School Districts, Higher Education Coordinating Commission (HECC), Cities, Public Defense Services Commission (PDSC), Counties, Education Service Districts (ESD)

**Analysis:**

The proposed legislation has been determined to have
