**Measure Description:**

Requires State Fire Marshal to adopt rules establishing minimum standards for carbon monoxide alarms in school facilities that have carbon monoxide source.

**Government Unit(s) Affected:**

Oregon State Police (OSP), School Districts, Education Service Districts (ESD)

**Analysis:**

This fiscal impact statement is for the purpose of transmitting the measure from the Senate Committee on Education to the Joint Committee on Ways and Means.

The measure directs the State Fire Marshall to adopt rules establishing minimum standards for carbon monoxide alarms in school facilities.

The measure is anticipated to have an impact on School Districts and Education Service Districts.
